David Oliver's Architectural Colours is a palette of perfect neutrals arranged chromatically into twenty-four groups of five gradual shades. Numbered I, II, III, IV and V from light to dark and warm to cool, each colour can be used either individually or in combination on ceiling, cornice, walls and woodwork.

A subtle variation of colour is an effective way of uniting all the architectural elements in a room, which are frequently painted white through habit or a lack of adventure. This colour by number system helps create a harmonious visual balance of mood, light and space, adding personality to the overall subconscious of the house.

The real beauty of David Oliver's paints are their prescriptive simplicity and creative versatility. Whether decorating a large stately home or a small pied-à-terre, these paint colours will benefit everyone from experienced designers and architects to individual homeowners that are addicted to colour and passionate about paint.



David Oliver is Design Director of Paint & Paper Library based in Chelsea, London.

He studied Fine Art, sculpture, painting, printmaking, photography and life drawing at the National Art School in Sydney where he developed an authoritative knowledge of twentieth century art and visual cultures. His work has been exhibited in Dublin, Madrid, New York, Sydney, Stockholm and London. Collections include the V&A Museum and the British Craft Council. 
